Venue: Hotel Taikanso 大観荘 (Japanese meaning is "House of Buena Vista") Matsushima, Miyagi, Japan

Matsushima is located on the Pacific coast of northeastern Japan, 20 km northeast of Sendai City and is easy to access by public transportation including train and bus. The Matsushima Bay is known as one of the three most gorgeous places to visit in Japan.

Dotted with more than 260 small islands, it offers spectacular scenes of natural beauty. The many islands and complex coastlines weakened the 2011 Tohoku tsunami and served to protect the town of Matsushima from more devastating damage. Now Matsushima is recovering from the 2011 damage.

The venue of the symposium is located on a hill with a panoramic view of the Matsushima Bay.
